Academics –

The result of our students has been 100 % result with over 30% students securing A1 grade. The overall average CGPA was 8.

Our children take part in the Olympiad and unified council examinations every year. These exams are instrumental in comparing and ascertaining the level of the students . I am delighted to inform you that like last year this year also our students are showing good performance in these exams. Last year two students Purva Singh Gaur of class III and Anshita Banere class ii had secured state level and international level ranking in English Olympiad. This year as the result of ISKO 2016 has been declared ,Rehan of class I – A has secured 14th zonal rank in ISKO and he would be awarded a prize money of Rs 2500 ,a medal and a merit certificate from NSO for the session 2016-17.

This year our first batch shall be appearing in the board examination scheduled to be held in March 2017. Your best wishes are sought for the students.

In the extra curricular activities our students have been participating in the various inter house ,inter class,intra class and inter school activities. From the very start of the session till today we have been conducting a number of well planned activities in the school where every effort has been made to provide opportunity to each and every child to participate.
