Special Assembly - World Nature Day


4th October, 202




Special Assembly- World Student Day





Many stories were narrated through PPTs to make them realise the importance of trees.


A small questionnaire was also held to make sure the understanding of concept to the children had reached properly. The session was conducted successfully with beautiful message on save trees.


